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2:15 PM School is over! Go home after school and start packing! Pack your luggage carefully and don't forget anything. You may want to pack a few snacks for the two long bus rides. Everything must be tagged or labeled with your name, address, and the name of the school. (You do NOT need to tag your instruments.) CEDAR POINT FIRST AID INFORMATION:

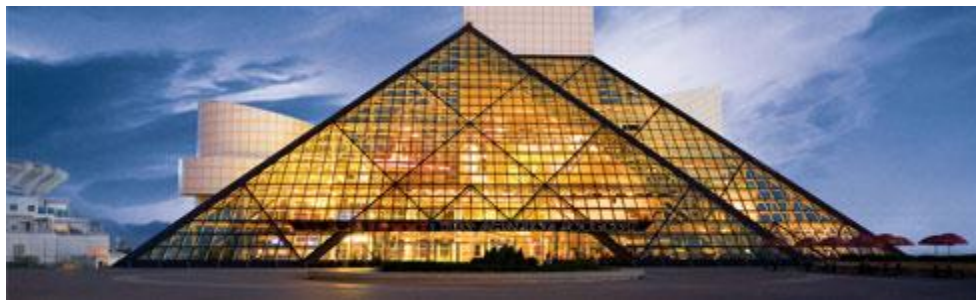

THE TRIP IS OVER, BUT HELP IS STILL NEEDED. EVERYONE SHOULD HELP UNLOAD ALL EQUIPMENT. BE SURE NOTHING IS LEFT INSIDE THE BUSES. HELP GET ALL INSTRUMENTS AND EQUIPMENT INTO THE SCHOOL.

TRIP GUIDELINES / RULES & REGULATIONS

GUIDELINES: We are going to Cleveland with a purpose. That purpose is to represent the Owen J. Roberts School District. While on the trip everyone's attitude and decorum must reflect with pride upon their school and themselves. Any deviation will not be tolerated. Remember, this is a school trip which means that the policies outlined in your student handbooks apply. Also remember, we are ambassadors from the State of Pennsylvania and from Owen J. Roberts.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1) **MR. MENGEL'S THOUGHTS ON BUS RIDES:**

Sleep as much as you want! A good deal of time will be spent on the buses. Remember to use good judgement at all times. Always be considerate of those around you, especially if you happen to be sitting right next to them on the bus. Always stay seated while buses are in motion and keep the noise level down to a minimum so others can rest if they want to. No speakers for music – headphones only!

2) **PUBLIC BEHAVIOR:**

Again, good judgement is called for at all times. Try not to look like "typical" high school students. Other people will be on vacation from around the country and do not want to get to know you. Any uncalled-for incident will result in your being excluded from future events.

3) **CURFEW:**

You will all be required to be in your rooms at curfew. (11:00pm) You will not be permitted to leave your room for any reason except in an emergency. Room checks will take place each night by your designated adult chaperone. After room checks each night, our private security guard will take over to monitor all of the rooms and make sure nobody leaves their room. You must wake-up at the indicated time on your itinerary for breakfast. I suggest calling the front desk for a wake-up call. You can also rest assured that the chaperones will be around in the morning to wake everyone up. Breakfast is a must for everyone!

4) **HOTEL ETIQUETTE:**

MR. MENGEL'S THOUGHTS ON HOTEL BEHAVIOR: *This is important!*

The Sheraton Cleveland is a first-class hotel and you are all expected to be "first-class" guests during our stay! **Please keep in mind that there are other guests staying at our hotel – they do not want to meet you, see you, or hear you! Other guests will complain if they hear loud noises and I am the one who will receive those complaints! Keep a low profile while at the hotel. No running down the halls, slamming doors, or running in and out of each others rooms.** There may be other guests on our floor or in rooms close to ours. Common sense, good judgment, and common courtesy apply at all times!

(rules & regs., continued...)

5) ALCOHOL/DRUGS:

Quite simply, this is the most important rule of all: THERE WILL BE **NO** DRINKING OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND/OR USE OF DRUGS AT ANY TIME DURING THE TRIP. **SCHOOL POLICIES AND DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURES WILL PREVAIL ON THE TRIP, AND WILL RESULT IN THE STUDENT BEING RETURNED HOME AT THE PARENT'S EXPENSE.** Don't take any chances – you're all too smart to even consider doing this. We will be checking for this constantly.

6) SMOKING:

There will be **NO** smoking or use of tobacco products at any time. Again, school policies and disciplinary procedures will apply.

7) STICK TO THE ITINERARY:

Obviously a trip like this requires careful planning. You have been provided with a well-planned and organized trip and can expect to follow all times to the letter. **YOU MUST BE PROMPT AT ALL TIMES!!!** Remember, this is a group trip and you are expected to follow a group itinerary! If you are late for an event you will hold up the entire group and there will be over 100 other people who will not be very pleased with you. If you are late for any reporting times, you will not be permitted to participate in future trips. This is definitely an important one for me!

8) ADULTS / CHAPERONES:

Adult chaperones will be assigned to check each room. The chaperones are there for your safety and well-being. Remember, our adults want to enjoy themselves and have a nice trip too. Your complete cooperation and extreme politeness will be anticipated!!! Report any problems (i.e. room damage, health concerns, questions, etc.) to your chaperone at any time during the trip. They will be responsible for giving you any of your needed tickets or vouchers, etc. throughout the trip.

MR. MENGEL'S SPECIAL REQUEST:

Your chaperone will be your liaison to me. Please direct all of your questions throughout the trip to your chaperone **FIRST**. If they can't help you, **THEN** come and find me. Most questions or problems can be answered and/or dealt with by your chaperone before I need to get involved. This will be very much appreciated by me throughout the trip.

9) DIRECTOR CELL PHONE:

TRIP SUGGESTIONS / REMINDERS

1) **DRESS / CLOTHING:**

Clean, comfortable clothing is appropriate for each day. All of you should bring your trip t-shirts to wear during the day at Cedar Point (after we perform). You also need a nice outfit for the dinner / dance cruise in Cleveland - nothing major – just something a bit nicer than normal – pants & shoes for guys, nice shirt, etc., appropriate dinner cruise outfit for gals. Also, take along your band jackets and/or a sweatshirt. Raingear is also recommended in case of inclement weather. Don't forget your swimsuits for the hotel pool and the water park.

2) **UNIFORM(S): Don't forget them! Are they cleaned and pressed? How about your hats & shoes?? Do you know where they are? What about black socks?? Do you have some?? We will not be wearing gloves.**

Place your band hats and shoes inside your garment bags – no hat boxes – uniforms will be stored on the bus in the upper storage compartments so you have quick access to them.

3) **PERSONAL ITEMS:**

- Sunglasses, Hats, Etc.

4) **SPENDING MONEY:**

You'll want to take a certain amount of money for personal spending for the following:
